I. Blessings in the Journey of Life... And the Lord appeared unto him the same night, and said, I am the God of Abraham thy father; **fear not**, for I am with thee, and will bless thee (Gen. 26:24)

_Don't be afraid because God did not give us the spirit of fear (II Tim. 1:7).

_God will never leave us alone, Jesus said that he would be with us even until the end of the world (Matt. 28:20).

II. Supplies in FamineAnd Elijah said unto her, **fear not**; go and do as thou hast said; but make me thereof a little cake first, and bring it unto me, and after make for thee and for thy son (I Kings 6:16)

_Don't be afraid but step out on faith, for we walk by faith not by sight (II Cor. 5:7).

_No matter how odd it might seem just take God at his word. God said that he would supply all our needs according to his riches in Christ Jesus (Phil. 4:9).

III. Protection in Peril.....And he answered, **fear not**; for they that be with us are more than they that be with them (II Kings 6:16)

_For if it had not been for the Lord on our side, now may Israel say (Ps 124:1)

_God promised us divine protection. David said that his angels are encamped all around us (Ps 34:7).

IV. Companionship in Trial..... **Fear not**, for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name, thou art mine. When thou passeth through the waters, I will be with thee, and through the rivers.....(Is. 43:1-3)

_God stays with his people in their trials. He told Joshua to be strong and of good courage for I am with thee (Joshua 1:6).

_God will never abandon us or leave us alone. He is a very present help in a time of trouble (Ps 46:1).
